



Cookies Policy

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1. What Cookies Are

Cookies are small text files stored on the user's device while using the customer portal admin.essw.pl and ESSW ERP instances. We use them solely for purposes necessary for the operation and security of the service and to remember interface preferences.

2. Cookies We Use

Type	Examples	Purpose	Duration
Session (strictly necessary)	application session identifier	maintaining the logged-in user session	until the session ends
Security (strictly necessary)	XSRF-TOKEN	protection against CSRF attacks	until the session ends
Login (functional)	remember_me, trusted device 2FA cookie	keeping the user logged in and skipping repeated two-factor verification on a trusted device	up to approx. 30 days (2FA — according to panel settings)
Preferences (functional)	light/dark theme, interface language	remembering appearance and language	up to 12 months

3. What We Do Not Do

- we do not use advertising or tracking cookies,
- we do not share cookie data with third parties for marketing purposes,
- we do not profile users based on cookies.

4. Managing Cookies

Your web browser allows you to delete stored cookies and block their storage. Blocking strictly necessary cookies (session and security) will prevent logging in and using the portal and ERP instances.

5. Related Data

In connection with cookies, technical data (IP address, browser information) described in the Privacy Policy is processed — for service security and diagnostics.
